Select TB patients to get free drugs as part of trial [MUMBAI MIRROR] December 11th, 2018

A select group of patients suffering from multi drug resistant (MDR) and extensively drug resistant (XDR) tuberculosis in the city will be given free doses of Delaminid as part of the drug's phase III trials. Patients from the rest of the state are not eligible for the programme which also covers Punjab, Rajasthan, Karnataka, Odisha, Kerala and Lakshadweep.

Tuberculosis forums to be set up for community engagement [THE NEW INDIAN EXPRESS]

Six months after the Union government sent guidelines to form Tuberculosis (TB) forums at state and district levels, a Government Order for setting up of state TB forums (with 33 stakeholders) and district TB forums (with 16 stakeholders), to eradicate the disease completely, was finally issued on November 30. According to the Government Order, meetings of the forums will be mandatory every six months.

Newcastle firm discovers new breakthrough antibiotic that can combat tuberculosis [CHRONICLE LIVE]

December 9th, 2018

A bioscience company in Newcastle has discovered a new antibiotic that could treat 600,000 cases of drug resistant tuberculosis every year. Demuris Ltd has worked with UK and US scientists, to identify the new antibiotic, which could help the 1.7 million people who die every year from tuberculosis. The new drug is known as Kanglemycin A and works by binding to an essential enzyme on the bacteria that causes the disease. However, crucially, it does not bind to the human enzymes.
